

BANQUET ROOM RENTAL FEES

Monday to Friday:	\$500 (members) \$750 (non-members)
Saturday afternoon & Sunday:	\$800 (members) \$1,000 (non-members)
Saturday evening:	\$1,000 (members) \$1,200 (non-members)
After Service Kiddush/Reception (3 hour maximum)	\$500 (members) \$750 (non-members)

These fees do not include a mandatory Building Manager fee of \$200, payable in cash at the time of the event. If set-up is required in advance of event, the fee is \$30/hour payable in cash to the Building Manager.

Conditions of Room Rental

- All room rentals require an executed contract between the parties.
- All rates are for up to five (5) hours except After Service Kiddush, which is three (3) hour maximum.
- Saturday afternoon affairs must conclude no later than 6:00 pm including clean-up.
- Rental fees include tables and chairs.
- Rental fees *do not* include linens, set-up or clean-up.
- **Caterers**: Only approved caterers are permitted in the Temple. A certificate of insurance must be provided. A list is available upon request. If you wish to use another caterer, information must be provided for approval. *It is mandatory that professional service staff be contracted to serve the food and clean the banquet room and kitchen.*
- All food must be kosher style: No shellfish, no pork, no meat/cheese combination dishes are allowed.
- Room capacity: The banquet room has a capacity of approximately 140 (with a dance floor) with the lobby wall in place so that the center lobby can be used as a separate cocktail hour space. The banquet room can be opened up as one large space to include the center lobby area in order to accommodate groups of approximately 180 guests (with dance floor).
